CODE OF CONDUCT - PLAYERS

Purpose

To inform players of the expectations of the Bonbeach YCW JFC in relation to their conduct. This covers all aspects of the player's association with the Bonbeach YCW JFC.

Guidelines

- Abide by the rules of the game and rules set down by your Coach, Club and League.
- Never argue with an official or umpire.
- Manage your emotions and always behave in a respectful way. Verbal or physical abuse of Officials, Umpires, Spectators or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted.
- Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit, so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team, opponent, or the other team. Be proud to walk off the ground after each game knowing that you have given your best effort and never involve yourself in an argument with opposing players, umpires or officials.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Remember that playing is for fun and enjoyment and that winning is only part of it.
- Co-operate with your coach and teammates and respect the ability of your opponent. Without them, there would be no game.
- Play for the "fun of it" and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Do not use derogatory or offensive language based on age, disability, race, sex, religion, gender identity and sexual orientation.
- Respect and look after all club property and facilities. Do not mistreat damage or vandalize.
- All Bonbeach YCW JFC players must also adhere to BBYCW JFC Social Media policy.

Non-Compliance

If a breach of the Bonbeach YCW JFC Code of Conduct occurs, disciplinary action may be applied at the discretion of the committee to impose any sanction on any person contravening the Bonbeach YCW JFC rules and regulations on any terms or conditions seen fit or to otherwise deal with such matter in any manner they in their absolute discretion think fit. Disciplinary action may include, but is not limited to, warnings, suspensions and or banning of players and is separate from any other penalty that may or may not be

applied by the league or Police for the same incident.

Implementation

All committee members will be made aware of this policy at the first committee meeting of the year.

All Players and their Parents and Guardians will be made aware of this policy, before the commencement of the season, via communication from their child's Coach/Team Manager and other club communication channels. The policy can be accessed on the club website [Club Policies | Bonbeachycwfooty](#)

The policy will be displayed at all club events and functions.

Review:
